

Accommodation

Students typically stay in halls of residence a short walk from classes and enjoy a good standard of accommodation that includes:

- Private room with en-suite bathroom and Wi-Fi access
- Shared, fully-furnished kitchen and living areas 5 students per kitchen
- Use of self-service laundry facilities

Students can choose to buy breakfast and lunch on campus, or prepare food themselves in their kitchens.
