

Bye-Law No. 4

Registration of Students and the Provision of Educational and Other Services by The University of Wolverhampton

1. Every student of the University of Wolverhampton (“the University”) is required:
 - (a) To enrol formally as defined at each stage of the course as a student of the University; and
 - (b) At that time to sign the enrolment document or accept an undertaking via the University’s designated online enrolment portal -
 - (i) To abide by the bye-laws, regulations, policies, rules, Codes of Conduct and admissions terms and conditions laid down by the University, and
 - (ii) To pay or cause to be paid to the University by the due dates all academic and non-academic fees and charges due to the University.

2. The University reserves the right to withhold the provision of all University services for any student who fails to enrol or agree to the admissions terms and conditions.
