

Bye-Law No. 3

Conduct Of Students

1. All students of The University of Wolverhampton are required to comply with such regulations, rules and codes of practice as may from time to time be made by the Board of Governors concerning the conduct of students and their attendance at the University.
2. All students of the University of Wolverhampton are required to comply with the requirements laid down from time to time by the Board of Governors in relation to tuition and other fees payable by or on behalf of students and to pay promptly and in full such fees as may be determined by the Board of Governors for the provision of tuition, accommodation, and other services by the University.
3. All students of the University of Wolverhampton are required to comply with such regulations and rules as may from time to time be made by the Academic Board concerning the admission and attendance of students on courses at the University, examinations and assessments of the academic performance of students, academic standards, the award of qualifications, procedures for the suspension of students for academic reasons, and such other academic matters as fall to be determined by the Academic Board.
4. All students of the University of Wolverhampton are required to comply with such policies as may from time to time be made by the Board of Governors or by the Academic Board and with such rules, instructions and directives as may from time to time be issued by the Vice-Chancellor of the University in accordance with the relevant sections of the Articles of Government concerning the character, mission, activities, organisation, direction and discipline of the University.
5. Any student in breach of this Bye-law shall be regarded as having committed a disciplinary offence and shall be subject to the disciplinary procedures of the University, which may include suspension, exclusion or expulsion from the University.
